Congratulations, you have now completed either the Wood Beads Part I and / or Wood Beads Part II, a.k.a. WB I or WB II training courses.

It is now my privilege to welcome you as a member of the 1st Stainsby (BPSC/TEAC) group. The insignia for the group is a Turks Head, two strand leather woggle known as the Stainsby woggle, earned at the completion of the WB I course. This woggle is worn with the group necker when in uniform. After completing the WB II course and receiving the Wood Beads beads and later the Stainby necker, the beads you can wear with your uniform all the time and the Stainby necker when the occasion allows, all three parts, woggle, beads and necker must be worn when attending any Stainby reunion.

Replacement of any lost Woggle, Beads or Stainsby necker can be purchased from the Quartermaster store upon production of Training proof.
